Tickets may be purchased at the Fort Concho Visitors Center in Barracks 1 located on South Oakes Street across from El Paseo or during the event at event location if space is available. Tickets may be requested by mail before November 30th and will be mailed to you. Tickets requested after this date must be picked up before or during the event at the Visitor Center. Telephone reservations are accepted for credit card purchases only.

Parking is conveniently located near Fort Concho at El Paseo de Santa Angela (between South Oakes Street and the Santa Fe Depot) and at the corner of Burgess and Henry O. Flipper Streets. Handicapped parking is available at the corner of Washington Drive and South Oakes Street.

Allow time to enjoy the grounds and visit the merchants and artisans before each event. In addition to the refreshments offered during featured events, food and beverages will also be available in the food court area near the Headquarters Building, and in the Arc Light Entertainment Area in Barracks 1.
