

INFORMATION

TICKETS & ADMISSIONS: Tickets may be purchased at Fort Concho at the Visitors Center in Barracks 1 or by calling (325) 481-2646.

PARKING: Parking is conveniently located near Fort Concho on South Oakes Street and on Henry O. Flipper Street. Handicapped parking is available at the corner of Washington Drive and South Oakes Street. Off-site street parking is also permitted. Please note that due to the great number of event participants, some parking areas around the historic site have been designated for participant parking.

FOOD & BEVERAGES: A variety of tempting refreshments are offered for your enjoyment. Food and Beverage vendors are conveniently located in the Food Court near Headquarters and on the Parade Ground near Barracks 2.

RESTROOMS: Restroom facilities are located throughout the Fort Concho grounds. Check the site map for specific locations.

EMERGENCIES: The fort's Visitors Center in Barracks 1 serves as headquarters for information, security, lost & found, and emergency operations. If you need assistance, please go to the main office in Barracks 1 or telephone (325) 481-2646 or (325) 657-4444.

HANDICAPPED FACILITIES: Designated parking for handicapped visitors is in the lot on the corner of Washington Drive and South Oakes Street. Handicapped accessible restrooms are located behind Officers' Quarters 1, in Barracks 1, in the Food Court and in the Stables.
